OHIO'S CONCUSSION AWARENESS LAW

(Law applies to all youth sports ages 4-17)

OHIO has passed a law, formerly House Bill 143, that requires all Coaches, Referees and league officials to undergo Concussion Awareness training every three years. This law applies to all youth sports including recreational, travel, indoor and premier soccer. The new law, ORC 3707.52 became effective April 26, 2013. One is run by the National Federation of High Schools (NFHS) and the other by the National Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
